Puppies Often Make Unscheduled Pit Stops

Q: Is it possible to create a schedule for housetraining a new puppy? If possible, I want to add reminders to my electronic calendar so I’m alerted whenever it’s time to take my puppy out. I’ll be getting a new puppy soon and wondered if this was feasible. -- Steve G., Baltimore

A: Certainly, it’s possible to schedule housetraining “events” into your day, and it may be helpful in training your new puppy faster. However, always make allowances for unscheduled trips outside, and unplanned accidents, which are all part of the training process. Puppies’ bladders are small, so they’ll need to go more frequently than an adult dog. In general, puppies must urinate about 10 to 15 minutes after each meal and have a bowel movement about 15 minutes after each meal. If you’re lucky, your pup will need to do both within about 5 minutes and you’ll only need to take him or her outside once after a meal. But don’t count on it.

Any time a puppy’s activity level or excitement level increases--such as when playing or when

guests arrive--he or she will need to urinate. Try to take the puppy outside as soon as it’s feasible, or just sigh and mop up the little puddle.

Remember that scolding doesn’t help much in housetraining: A puppy’s attention span is so short that once the deed is done, he’s forgotten it. So rubbing his nose in his mess will do little but confuse him. Instead, clean up and try again.

The more often you take your puppy out to the potty area in the first few weeks he is with you, the sooner he will catch on and think, “This is the place for me to go! Not inside where I sleep!” Repetition and routine help immensely in housetraining.

Try limiting the amount of water a puppy drinks overnight. Keep the bowl full during the day, of course; but limiting water at night could lessen the frequency of overnight potty trips. Remember: keep trying, be patient and give your puppy lots of encouragement. He’ll get it eventually!

Collector’s Items ♦ ♦ ♦

Kelly Comfort Chair

Q : I have a Kelly Comfort Automatic Chair that was manufactured in Clinton, Iowa. I have seen an identical chair in a local antique shop tagged at \$2,000 and have been told that it was crafted in 1905. Where can I sell my chair?--Thea, Shawnee, Kan.

A : Just because a dealer has a hefty price tag on an item does not mean that it is actually worth that amount. Recently I saw a piece of cut glass in a shop that was priced about three times what it was truly worth. The dealer told me that he especially liked the piece and did not really want to sell it. That explained his inflated price. A search of my reference books failed to reveal any information about either the Kelly Comfort Chair or the company that manufactured it. There are two major auction houses in Kansas that might be able to help you. AAA Historical Auction Service is highly recommended by my readers in that region. The postal address is P.O. Box 12214, Kansas City, KS 66112. The second auction house is CC Auction Service, 416 Court, Clay Center, KS 67432.

Q : I have a small collection of 78 rpm recordings, including at least one cut by Caruso. Most appear to be classical and are from the 1940’s--Jeanette, Festus, Mo.

A : Older 78s are almost impossible to sell. Turntables to play them are becoming difficult to find, and most of the earlier recordings of interest have been reissued on tape and CDs. With that said, let me refer you to Les Docks, a San Antonio dealer who occasionally buys selected 78s. Please note the words “occasionally” and “selected.” His address is P.O. Box 691037, San Antonio, TX 78269.

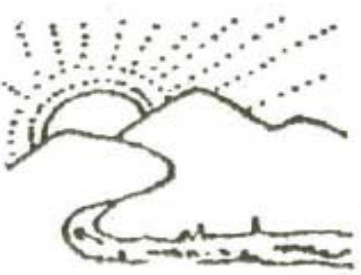

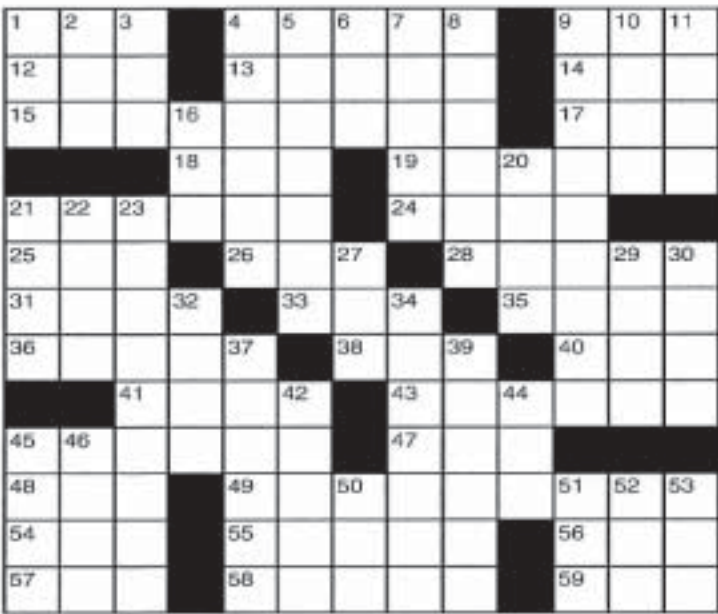

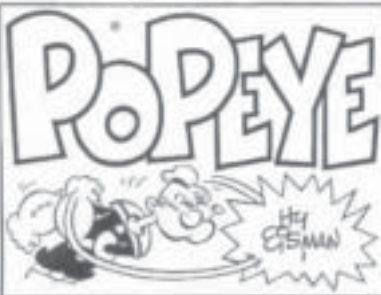
